



Announcing Admissions to Class 11



April 2017-18

Strawberry Fields High School offers admission to students in Class 11 for the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme.

Subject selection is a significant endeavour, which will be confirmed after the applicant takes the entrance test and attends a counselling session with their parents/guardians and the school management.

Diploma Programme students are required to take 6 subjects - 3 subjects at Higher Level (HL) and 3 subjects at Standard Level (SL) along with the **compulsory** IB DP Core which consists of Theory of Knowledge; Creativity, Activity and Service; Extended Essay.

Students need to take one subject each from Groups 1 to 5, for the sixth subject they can choose from Group 6, or take another subject from Groups 3 and 4.

Our timetable for the IB DP has been created to accommodate selection of subjects which are required for most of the popular career paths. In order to cater to the widest variety of subject preferences, there is a restriction on certain combinations of subjects that we can offer. Following is a list of subject combinations, which are currently **not** permissible, given the structure of our timetable:

- Biology / Physics / Art – Choose One
- Chemistry / Computer Science / French ab initio – Choose One
- Psychology / History – Choose One

Important Note: However, if you feel that you need to choose a particular combination that is not offered, please write an application to the Principal detailing your request and we will try and accommodate your selection.

Eligibility: Students seeking admission should have completed 10 years of education from a recognized school and attained a minimum of 80% in their Internal School Assessment / Pre-Board Examination.

Students are required to fulfil the following conditions to gain admission to the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme at Strawberry Fields High School:

- Student and parent / guardian are required to attend an interaction with a member of the school management (Director, Principal, Chief Mentor or High School & IB DP Coordinator) to be apprised about the structure of the IB DP and provide opportunity for them to gain greater clarity about the programme so that they make an informed choice about pursuing the programme.
- Students should have passed a recognised secondary board examination for Class 10 in all subjects they had undertaken - students will be granted a provisional admission till results from the external boards are published (academic year for Class 11 begins from mid April).
- There will be placement examinations for certain subjects they wish to pursue at Higher Level, in which students must attain atleast 80% (Sciences – Biology, Chemistry and Physics and Mathematics). All students will be required to take English and Mathematics examinations to gauge their attainment to facilitate a meaningful interaction with the parents and student for course selection.

Selection: Eligible students will be required to appear for a Placement Test and an Interaction. The final selection will be on the basis of the applicant's overall performance. Placement Test for admission to Class 11, will be conducted on April 18, 2017 at 9:00 am. Selected students will be intimated by April 21, 2017.

An Orientation for Students / Parents will be held on April 22, 2017 from 11:30 am to 12:30 pm. Admission fee must be deposited in the school office, on April 21 or April 22, 2017 between 10:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. Classes commence from April 24, 2017.

- Character Certificate from previous school
- Latest passport size photograph of the student
