OUR SCHOOL



SFHS was established in April 2004 under the aegis of the Durga Das Foundation, a non-profit organisation committed to enhancing quality education, culture, and community development. We welcome students ranging from 5 to 18 years of age, providing a comprehensive educational journey that encompasses IB PYP from Kindergarten to Grade 5, ICSE for Grades 6 to 10, and a choice between ISC and IBDP for Grades 11 and 12, enriched by an inclusive SEN department. Embracing the ethos of the Right to Education Act (2009), we currently extend admission to 25% of students from economically weaker sections of society. Additionally, SFHS serves as a center for the SAT.

OUR ASSESSMENT

Subject selection in the High School is a significant endeavour, which is discussed thoroughly at counselling sessions between the candidate, parents/guardians, and the school management. We aim to provide as much flexibility and choice as possible in subject selection, subject to timetabling restrictions.

Council for the Indian School Certificate Examination

SFHS conducts two national examinations, the Indian Certificate of Secondary Education (ICSE in Grade 10) and the Indian School Certificate (ISC Grade 12), which are known in India for their rigour. The course at both levels includes a practical and/or project component, which are externally moderated. The ICSE is a two-year programme for Grades 9 and 10 where students at SFHS study the following subjects:

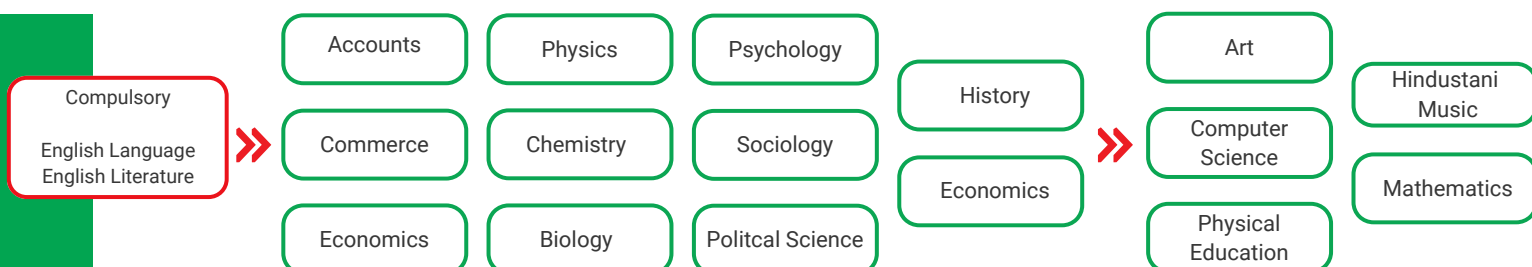

The ISC is a two-year programme for Grades 11 and 12 where students must study English Language and Literature and choose another 4 subjects. At SFHS the students can choose from the following subjects:



In addition to the above, Grades 9 - 12 have regular access to Physical Education, Performing Arts, and a host of co-curricular activities as well as Socially Useful and Productive Work along with Community Service. Examination results are in percentage form and go with a detailed report of the student's performance every six months. For admissions to colleges/universities we predict percentages in October (Set 1) and February (Set 2) for Grade 12.

International Baccalaureate

Since April 2017, students in Grades 11 and 12 have been choosing to study the two-year IB Diploma Programme (in which the first cohort graduated in 2019). SFHS offers the following subjects from which students must choose.

In order to achieve an IB Diploma, students must complete six subjects. They are required to take one subject each from Groups 1 to 5. For the sixth subject, students can choose from Group 6, or take another subject from the other five groups. Generally, each subject is offered at both Standard Level (SL) and Higher Level (HL). Students must take three subjects at Standard Level and three subjects at Higher Level. They must also complete the IB Core course together with the required subjects.

Assessment reports with IBDP Grades are issued twice a year. For admissions to colleges/universities we predict grades in October and February for IBDP Year 2. The interactive capabilities of ManageBac and Turnitin are used to deliver the programme efficiently. All laboratories ensure optimum use of opportunities, which the comprehensive curriculum provides.

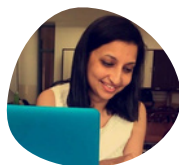

OUR SCHOOL PERFORMANCE

For the academic session 2022-23, the School's ISC Grade 12 students have attained No. 1 Rank in all streams - Medical, Non-Medical, Commerce and Humanities across the tri-city of Chandigarh, Panchkula and Mohali. Our ICSE Grade 10 student attained No. 3 Rank in the tri-city.

Our IB DP students attained an overall average grade that is substantially higher than both the national and global averages.
